The choir is professionally-directed by Christopher Cromar, one of the UK's most experienced church musicians and a conductor and choir-trainer of national repute. The choir rehearses in the church on Fridays from 5.45pm to 6.45pm.

We aim to provide an opportunity for children to sing in a high-level choir under expert guidance while enhancing their musical potential.

Members will receive free outstanding voice training and instruction in the rudiments and theory of music while working towards two services a month in St Andrew's and a limited

number of high-profile local engagements, radio broadcasts etc. All dates are published at least two months in advance.

The choir will provide young singers with the opportunity to benefit from the widely-acknowledged educational benefits of being involved in music-making, as well as the challenges and rewards of musical teamwork. Rehearsals will be both educational and enjoyable, and will develop transferable skills which should prove useful in day-to-day school life.

We aim to cater for children with a wide experience of singing as well as those with no previous experience. Potential, enthusiasm and a willingness to commit to weekly term-time rehearsals is what's required.
